Son files a suit for recovery of the amount. State along with reasons whether son can recover the amount under the Indian Contract Act, 1872

Q3.Do the following statements amount to involvement of fraud? Pen down your reason. Where the vendor of a piece of land told a prospective purchaser that, in his opinion, the land can support 2000 heads of sheep whereas, in truth, the land could support only 1500 sheep.

Q4. Ajay entered into an agreement with Sanjay to deliver five dozen bottles of a particular brand of champagne to be manufactured in his factory. The champagne could not be manufactured because of strike by the workers and Ajay failed to supply the said dozen of champagne to Sanjay. Decide whether Ajay can be exempted from liability under the provisions of the Indian Contract Act, 1872.

a. *Amit promises a subscription of Rs. 10,000 as donation to the National Defense Fund. He does not pay.* Is there any legal remedy against him?

b. Akhil, an adult said to Mukul, a minor – "I will not pay you the commission I promised you for selling my magazine". Can Mukul claim his commission?
