Amidst the growing concern for the economy and release of the annual budget by the government on 1st February 2020, Jaipuria Noida organized a "Budget Conclave" on 3rd February 2020 to discuss the important reforms in the annual budget. The conclave comprised a panel discussion by various esteemed speakers that encompassed, Mr. Harsh Biyani, Director-PWC, Mr. Rajesh Kumar, Finance Officer- Power Finance Corporation, Mr. Vineet Singhal, CFO Gaursons Group of companies, and Mr. Eish Taneja, MD Eish Taneja & Associates as they shared with the students, their different views on the 'signals' that can be derived from the budget. Dean Academics (Prof.) Dr. Pratibha Wasan welcomed and felicitated the guests with the customary green certificates and shared her views on the subject matter emphasizing the importance of understanding the budget as different 'signals' can be derived related to what the government is doing for the economy.

Taking the discussion further, **Mr. Biyani** talked about the tax reforms in the recent budget and described to the students about the difference between new and old tax regime. Students were also made aware of the changes in corporate taxes and their impact on the economy as a whole. Sharing his experience from the power sector, **Mr. Kumar** shared his views about the recent amendments in tax policies and the abolishment of dividend distribution tax.

Dr. Ritika Gugnani, Moderator of the panel discussion shared, how through this budget, the government is not ready to take any shortcuts and is preferring long and sustainable growth. Moving forward, **Mr. Taneja** acknowledged the existence of intellect in the country but talked about the requirement of efficient infrastructure to utilize that intellect. He also explained to the students about the "Vivaad se Vishwas" Scheme which will help reduce tax disputes.

On the connotation, "A stitch in time saves you nine", Mr. Singhal elaborated on the positive impact of budget on the real estate and housing sector. The session concluded with the presentation of mementos to the guests by Dr. Ritika Gugnani, Dr. Puneet Dublish & Dr. Vranda Jain respectively. The session provided an enriching and enlightening experience to the students as the Panelists also answered all the queries related to the reformed tax regime, subsidiaries and FDIs by the students.

GL UNDER FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

Carrying the legacy of providing faculty and students an opportunity to underpin newer ways of teaching-learning process and thereby reaching out to new places, meeting new people and making new friends, Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida under Faculty Exchange Programme invited, **Dr. Aparna Mendiratta** – Asst. Professor HR/OB, Jaipuria Institute of Management, Jaipur on **Thursday 06th Feb., 2020.** She delivered sessions to the HR elective students of 2019-21 and 2018-20 batches. HR area colleagues, **Prof. JS Kaushal, Dr. Swati Agrawal, Dr. Shalini Srivastava, Dr. Rahul Singh and Dr. Abdul Qadir** with other colleagues from Noida campus all joined together to welcome Dr. Aparna.

Dr. Aparna delivered three sessions wherein two on the topic "Managing in the Gig Economy" and one, on "OD & Diversity Management".
