GL ON WORKPLACE HARASSMENT

In the course of preparation for their journey towards success in corporate world, the sixth semester students in the course "Career Advancement through Personal Effectiveness", attended a guest session on the topic of "Legal Aspects Of Workplace Harassment" by Ms. Preeti Pahwa, Corporate Lawyer and trainer, Eminds Legal.

The session addressed different types of workplace harassment including sexual harassment i.e., sharing offensive jokes, intimidation, humiliation, spreading rumours, etc. For the further understanding of such types of harassment, A lot of varied examples were discussed to understand each type of harassment and quizzes were taken up where everybody put their views forward, making the session interactive enough to gauge more knowledge on the topic.

Various laws related to workplace harassment including Misconducts under the standing orders and under S&E act, Code and conduct policies, Unfair Labour Practice under the 5th schedule of Industrial Dispute Act, 1947, Code of Wages, Equal Remuneration Act, Indian Penal Code, Industrial Dispute Act, the most recent POSH- Prevention of Sexual Harassment, etc. were discussed during the session. All these topics were discussed taking their roots from the Law: Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act, 2013) which was notified on 9th December, 2013 with an objective of Prevention, Prohibition, Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women.

Furthermore, different examples of Offensive Acts/ Behaviours were also taken into account, citing the kinds of touch, the power used to further such intention and the threat posed if not, someone complied with the same. Certain instances of #MeToo movement were discussed; a number of videos, advertisements shown during the session added to the overall efficacy of the session.


