INAUGURAL OF FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME IN MANAGEMENT

Diversifying the courses, the institute offers, Jaipuria Noida held a virtual inaugural session for the new **"Fellowship Programme in Management"** course for research scholars, on **4th September 2020.** The session began with **Dr. Deepak Pandit** addressing and welcoming all the doctoral scholars and shared various metaphors from his journey while relating a research scholar to a pebble in water and the various streams that takes the pebble to various places. However, the journey ends when the pebble (scholar) gathers strength and conviction to take a stand in the flowing stream. He also urged them to build their foundations during their course work so that by investing time they can gain knowledge for further study.

Moving forward, **Dr. D.N. Pandey**, Director Jaipuria Noida welcomed the chosen scholars as the first batch of FPM course, along with all the faculty members. Dr. Pandey called it a historical event for the campus as the institute has been working hard to improve itself for all the stakeholders since its inception 16 years ago. Recognizing the need for research domain, Chairman **Mr. Sharad Jaipuria**, and Vice-Chairman **Mr. Shreevats Jaipuria** introduced FPM program. The initiative is aimed to add value to college as well as the scholars. Dr. Pandey commended the existing faculty members for promoting research in the campus and further extended support to the previous Dean Research, **Dr. Shalini Srivastava** and **Dr. Ashwani Kumar**, followed by **Dr. Tavishi Tiwari** and **Dr. Deepak Pandit** for taking initiative for driving FPM prog along with **Dr. Keshav Sharma** as Research Coordinator, Dean Academics, Dean Student Affairs, and faculty members. He also shared various tips and his insights that he gained over the years while discussing the literal meaning of 'research' as careful and diligent study of any domain.

The chief guest of the session, **Dr. Sanjeev P. Sahni**, Principal Director, Jindal Institute of Behavioural Sciences (JIBS), O P Jindal University, was welcomed by Dr. Pandey, with the customary green certificate. Dr. Sahni appreciated the efforts of Dr. Pandey and the institute for introducing such program. He emphasized the need of having passion and drive to dig into a particular research study area as it requires hard work and efforts. 'How to formulate research problem' is the one of the most important part of research followed by the methodology used. He also discussed the availability of many software and programs to help the methodology and analysis, followed by the differences between qualitative and quantitative analysis involved. He urged on the importance of reading and having analytical mindset to excel in research and advised the scholars to be optimistic and accept change whenever it may come. Before concluding his session, he also offered all the research scholars to avail stay facility at Jindal campus for free and access their library resources.

The insightful session concluded with a brief Q&A session with the audience.
