The maps that played were Erangel, Miramar, and sank in the classic squad mode of the game. The game played in three rounds.15 teams qualified for the second round.



The stars of the match were Teer, Gujjar and Roborant.







THE CRISIS AVERSION

Gravity gave everyone a chance to display his or her talent and impress through their favorite dance form following a knockout trend of competing.


