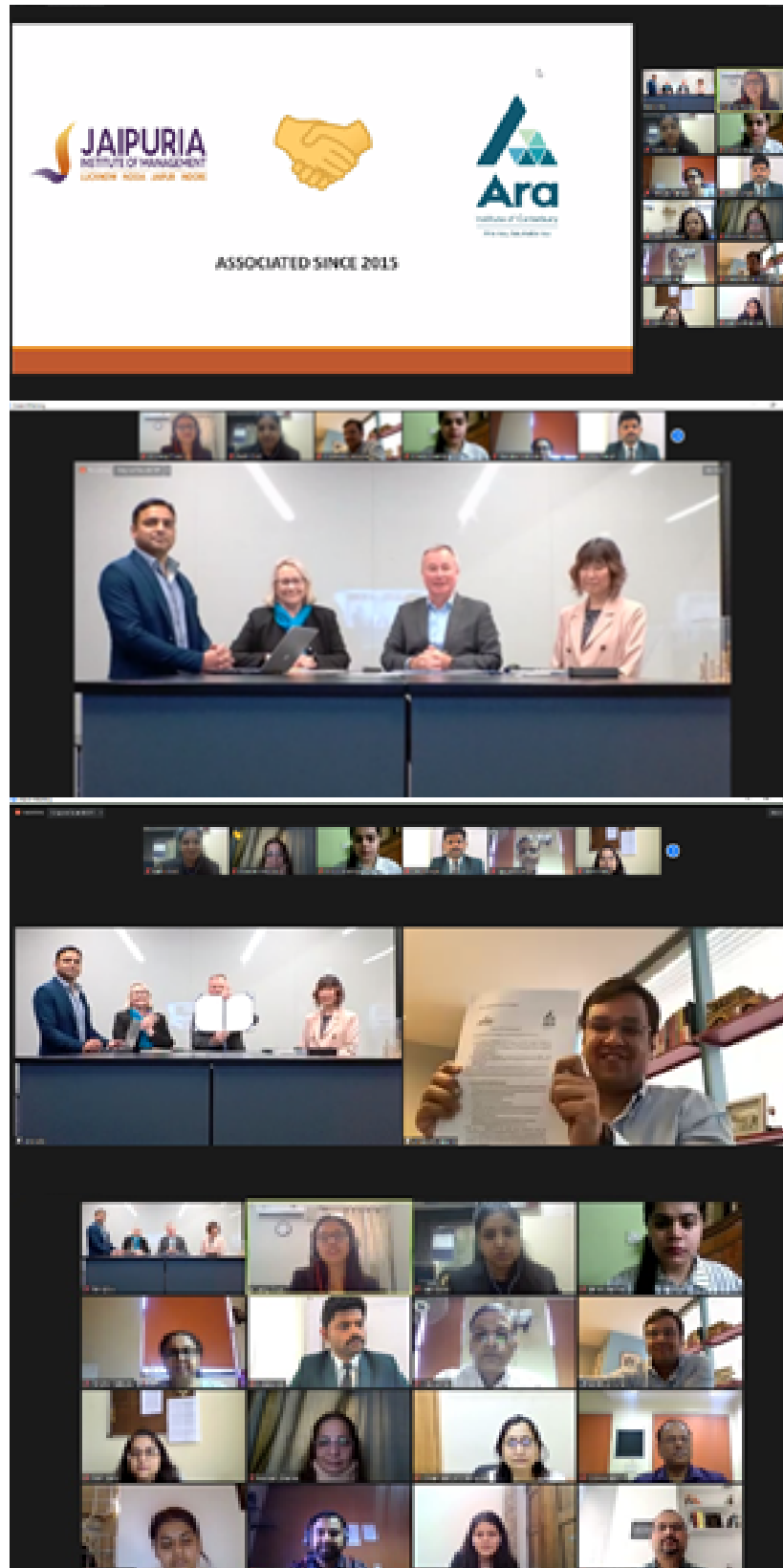

SIP MANTRA

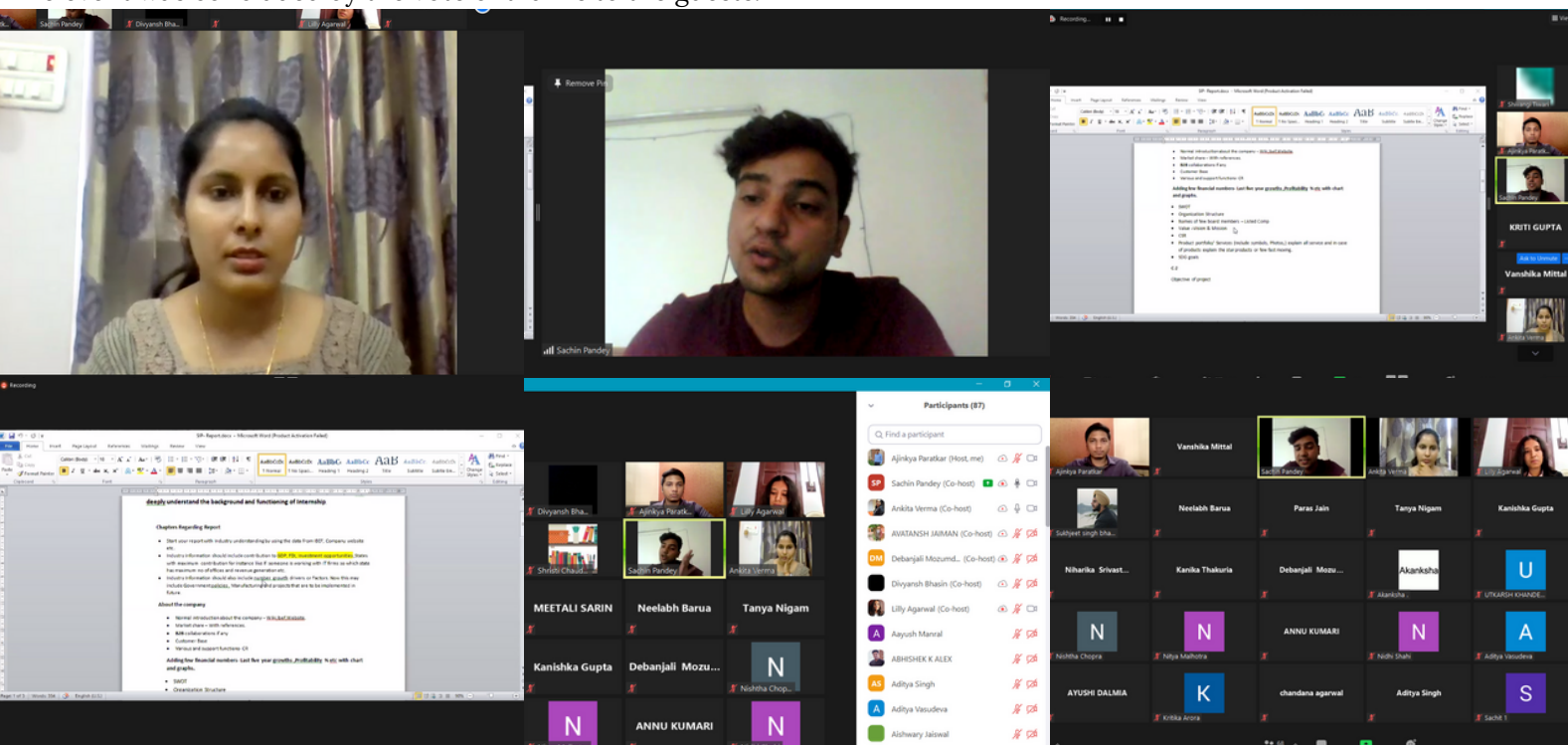
