






BUSINESS MODEL CANVAS- YOU

"You continuously compete with others, you become bitter, but if you continuously compete with yourself, you become better".





After all the hustle to pitch the ideas, Chill karlein led by Mr. Shivam along with Ms. Shubhangi Sharma and Ms. Sehar Popli were declared the winners as they generated an investment of Rs. 40 Lakhs with 20% equity by Dr Ankur Chauhan. The runner up was Due Care led by Mr. Aryaman Jaisawal who generated an investment of Rs. 40 Lakhs with 40% equity by Ms. Biijal Shah.

At the end, both the sharks gave their insights and motivated all the participants for their respective ventures. Overall, the event was a huge success and a great source of learning for all the participants.






ENTREPRENEUR'S MEET

CLOSING CEREMONY OF E WEEK 2022





With this the event was marked successful with an ending quote by Ms. Vanshika "Winning is not everything participating is".






GUEST TALK ON EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE




