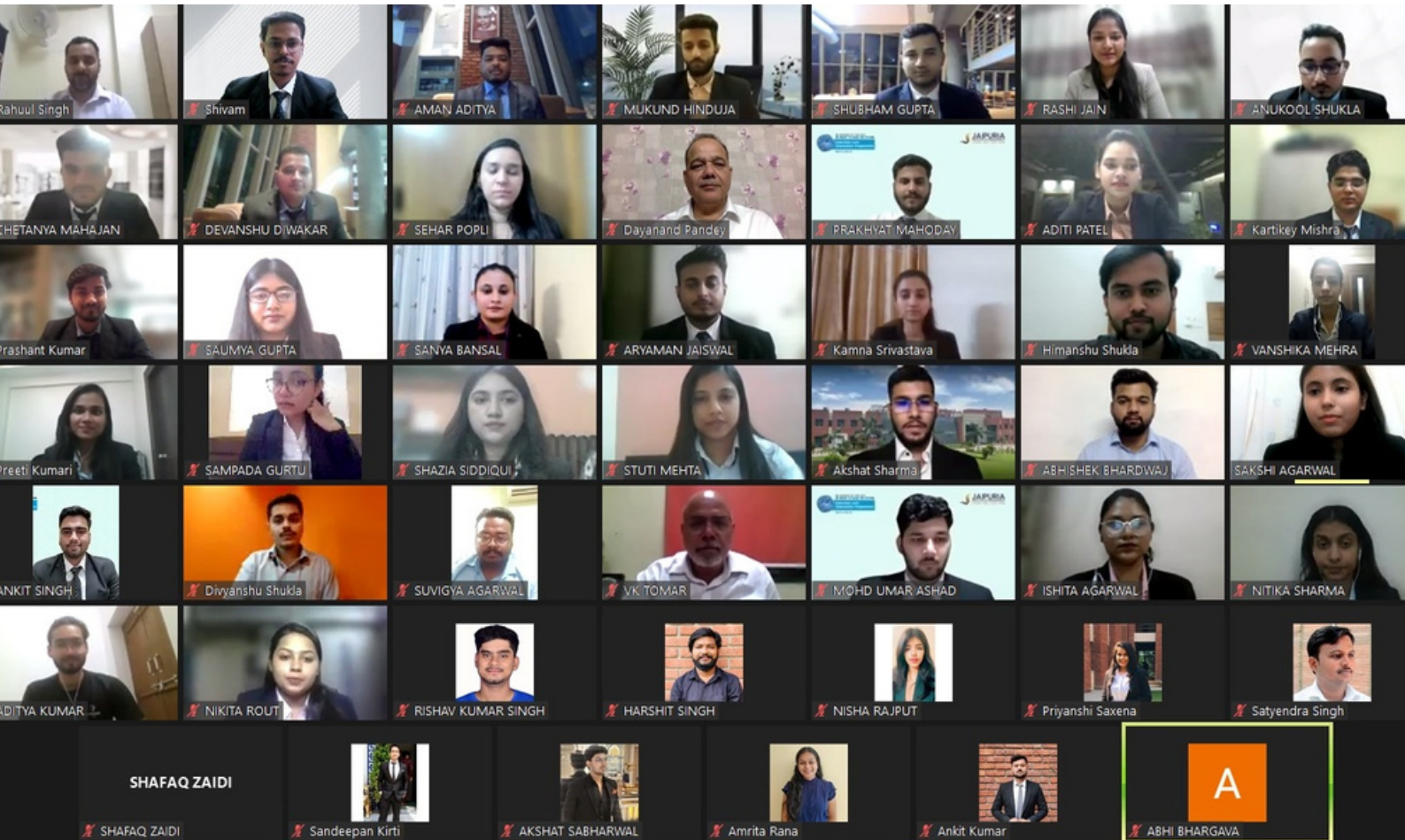

The session concluded by congratulating every member and wished them good luck with their roles and responsibilities.

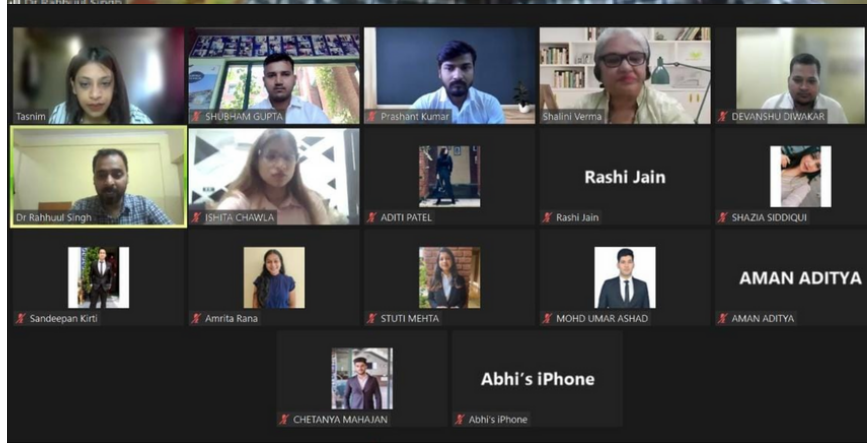
# MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS
