SIGNING OF MOU WITH MIDDLESEX UNIVERSITY-DUBAI

A step towards a new endeavour has been taken by the International Relations Office of Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida as it has successfully signed the MOU with Middlesex University, Dubai.

The official collaboration signing ceremony was organized at Middlesex University, Dubai in the presence of **Dr Cedwyn Fernandes**, Pro-VC & Director at Middlesex University, Dubai and **Dr D.N. Pandey**, Director at Jaipuria Institute of Management Noida

The scope of cooperation includes the exchange of faculty and/or students. It will enable students to study at both universities through an exchange program and benefit from a global learning experience. The agreement will also enable faculty and students to participate in joint research projects and academic conferences.

INTERNAL RESEARCH SEMINAR



Jaipuria Noida organized another knowledge-sharing session for all faculty members on November 16th, 2022. **Dr Ashish** presented his work on technology diffusion, and **Prof. Sonali** discussed her ongoing research on the service quality of e-retailers. Dr Ashish shared his views on technology adoption and diffusion and how they are different to each other, which needs to be understood carefully. Similarly, Dr Sonali explained various aspects of service quality and their importance for e-retailers. Their colleagues quite appreciated their research work and the relevance of the topics. Faculty colleagues shared some future research ideas on the topics, including the relevance of common method bias and other validity issues in research. The session was highly informative and engaging for all the colleagues.





MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS



A 6-day FDP on "SLR and Qualitative Analysis" has been organized by Jaipuria Noida for faculty members in a hybrid mode. The resource person for the FDP is **Dr Amandeep Dhir**, Professor-Research Methods, at the University of Agder. The FDP started on November 11th, 2022 with a detailed discussion on the qualitative data coding process. Faculty members also presented their research ideas to Prof. Dhir and received detailed feedback. Dr Dhir. shared his views on qualitative analysis and ethics in the data collection process. He explained types of qualitative research and its growing significance in the academic sector. Moreover, he discussed the interview questions design and emphasised on neutral approach to data collection. The FDP program is slated to culminate on 8th December with offline interaction with the resource person.
