To reflect upon the challenges and explore the opportunities in the logistics sector Government of India has launched National Logistics Policy (NLP) 2022 on September 17, 2022. This would be a game-changing initiative as it proposes a framework for creating sustainable and efficient logistics in the country. GUEST SESSION ON POSH BY ICC



The Internal Complaint Committee (ICC) of the Jaipuria Noida organized a guest session for all its faculty & staff members on 30th November from 2 pm-3 pm on POSH Act 2013 (Prevention and protection of women from sexual harassment at the workplace) to ensure a safe working environment for women.

The Guest Speaker **Brig. Dr Ramesh Chandra** highlighted the 3 main components of this agreement, such as gender equality in the workplace, gender-specific violence, and inappropriate sexually coloured behaviour, and how these are used to create a robust legislative framework. Dr Ramesh Chandra appreciated the effort taken by ICC-Jaipuria Noida as many employers do not know about the law and legal responsibilities related to POSH. The training session apprised all the members present about prevention, prohibition and protection from sexual harassment at the workplace. He shared that POSH training has been compulsory in India since 2013 when the ACT was passed. He also discussed about what comes under workplace sexual harassment, the process of filing the complaint against it, the procedure of redressal of the issue and the consequences and penalties for non-compliance. The participants were educated on the following pointers:

- How to create a safe work environment for women in the workplace
- A clear understanding of sexual harassment
- How to handle such incidents and improve productivity
- Constituting Internal Complaint Committee & its members
- The redressal mechanism

The interactive session ended with a vote of thanks to the guest speaker & felicitating him with a green certificate by Dean Academics **Prof Dr Tarun Dhingra**.

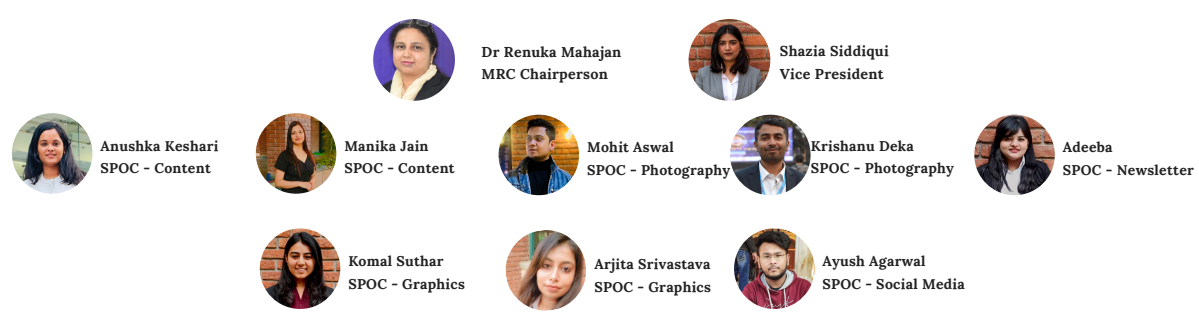
