UAE Alumni Chapter Meet (via Zoom)


15th April 2023, Saturday @ 8.00 pm

GUEST TALKON ON MS-PROJECTS (PROJECT MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE BY MICROSOFT)

As part of the Project Management course, Term VI, a one-day hands-on training workshop on MS PROJECTS (Project Management Software by Microsoft) was organised for students of Group 1 & Group-2 on April 8, 2023 (Saturday) in BA Lab, Noida campus. External expert **Mr Naveen Mishra**, a Project Management Consultant & Trainer along with course faculty **Dr Keshav Kr Sharma** conducted the workshop. The objective of the workshop was to train students in the software which is popularly used in managing projects across various industries. Students learned about the various features available in the MS PROJECTS software and received hands-on training on planning, scheduling, monitoring and controlling projects using the software. With real-world project examples, students learned the use of software in developing project schedules, estimating and assigning resources, levelling over-allocated resources, setting schedule & cost baselines, tracking project progress, monitoring project progress using Earn Value Management and generating project reports.







HRIS WORKSHOP FOR HANDS-ON LEARNING

In the Course of Human Resource Information System (HRIS) for the HR Specializing Students of 2021-23

Batch at Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida on 5, 12 & 19 April 2023

To take classroom learning to the next level, a 05 session hands-on workshop in the HRIS course for the students of the sixth trimester, was organized in the virtual mode on 5, 12 & 19, April 2023. The resource person of the workshop was **Mr Govil Singla**, Sr. HRIS Manager, Adrenalin eSystems, Gurugram (India). HRIS course faculty, **Dr Abdul Qadir** welcomed Mr Singla followed by his introduction and presentation of a green tree certificate.

The workshop began with an initial introduction to HRIS and its related session-wise coverage. The five sessions of the said workshop included modules like; Organization Structure & Employee Life Cycle, Talent Acquisition Module & Application Tracking System (ATS), Modules on PMS, Leave & Attendance, Confirmation, Travel & Expense and Onboarding & Employee Separation. The pedagogy adopted by the resource person for all these modules was configuration and hands-on demonstration of the working of the HR functions and processes. Students were provided with their individual "Access Credentials" for the software, Adrenaline & EmployWise to practice and learn hands-on. To keep the sessions engaging and purposeful, Mr Govil kept the participants occupied with questions and proper explanations of those. To ensure the learning from the workshop, an exhaustive integrated project followed by an individual assessment that finally culminated in the form of certifications.

Students found this workshop extremely useful before embarking upon their corporate journey and endorsed that this workshop has added extremely important values to their learning curve. In the end, Mr Govil also appreciated the students and their curiosity about learning about HRIS. Dr Abdul Qadir shared his parting thoughts and appreciated the resource person and students who made this workshop a grand success.
