This Adivasi environmental activist hails from the Santal community in Jharkhand, India, and has devoted her whole life to protecting forests.

As Smt. Tudu nurtures a deep love for nature, she has founded Van Suraksha Samiti (Forest Protection Committee) for the protection of the environment. In 1998, she started this Samiti in her village, Muturkham. What had started as just an informal collective of neighbourhood women devoted to protecting the local jungle, has now evolved into a region-wide movement of over 400 villages and 10,000 members, mainly women.

Smt. Tudu passionately addressed the students, highlighting the pressing issues of environmental conservation, the need to preserve forests and their role in maintaining ecological balance, as well as the relevance of women's empowerment in promoting sustainable projects, throughout her engaging speech.

Her presentation was followed by an array of thought-provoking questions on environmental issues from the inquisitive students. Smt. Tudu answered all the questions, motivating the students to engage actively in various social activities.

The third session of the day was the interaction of the Student Excellence with the students. The new batch was sensitized that personal growth is not solely dependent on one's academic pursuits but also on co-curricular activities. And in this aspect, the Noida campus has a well-structured extracurricular yearly calendar.
