#### **SESSION ON IT RESOURCES & MOODLE FUNCTIONALITY**

Day 8: July 24, 2023



The eighth day of the Orientation program began with an introductory session delivered by **Mr. Satyendra Singh** (IT Head). The goal of this session was to demonstrate our campus's learning management system (LMS) and IT capabilities, as well as how its staff is available to assist students at all stages. There were in-depth discussions on the software and learning tools that the Institute provides to its students. A demo was provided on the use of the institute's LMS and related modules. Overall, the session was quite detailed, and the students asked several technical questions. The Head of IT support and his team promised full cooperation to students throughout their stay at Jaipuria to make their learning journey easier and more fruitful.







#### SESSION ON LIBRARY AND ONLINE RESOURCES

Day 8: July 24, 2023



Mr. Jitender Sharma, Senior Librarian, conducted the joint session on Library and Online Resources for all the sections in the Auditorium – 1 and 2. Mr. Jitender Sharma started the session by welcoming all the students and briefing them about the library. He went on to describe the different collections in the library, including textbooks, reference books, audio/videos/CDs/DVDs, previous years' project reports, journals, magazines, bound volumes of past issues of the journals, etc. He then described the online resources of the library and how they could be accessed. He explained in detail the online solutions at jaipuria.mapmyaccess.com, which would act as a single platform to get and view all digital resources of the library. He also gave a live demonstration of the entire platform and taught students how to create their accounts for User-ID and Password-based resources. He covered all leading databases, including Capitaline, Statista, the World Ebooks Library, J-Gate, the EPWRF Time Series Database, Science Direct, Scopus, the DSpace Digital Library developed in-house by the Jaipuria, Noida libraries, and all other databases subscribed to by the library. He further explained how students can make use of millions of open-access resources and how they can do MOOC courses through different platforms available on the library website. He then responded to the student's queries and invited them to visit the library and check out all the available collections themselves.





#### **MENTOR-MENTEE SESSION**

Day 9: 25 July, 2023

The Induction-cum-Orientation Program for the batch of 2023-25 at Jaipuria Institute of Management witnessed an enriching Mentor-Mentee Interaction Session on the 24th and 25th of July 2023. The session was organized by the Mentoring Chair, **Dr. Ajay Bansal**, and saw active participation from faculty mentors across all areas.

The session commenced with a warm introduction, allowing mentors and mentees to get acquainted with each other.
