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
MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS

August 16, 2023





The topic of the session was "Functioning of an Executive Search Firm", in the HR elective course, "Talent Acquisition". The guest was welcomed with a green certificate by the hosting faculty of the session **Dr. Pragya Gupta.** Mr. Shambhu Agrawal's insightful presentation revolved around the intricate challenges stemming from resource limitations within organizations. His emphasis on the Talent Supply Chain underscored its pivotal role in maintaining a competitive edge, highlighting key players who drive this dynamic landscape. He talked about growing sectors in upcoming years where Talent Acquisition will play a significant role. The topics on which he discussed with us were Talent Supply Chain, the functioning of an executive firm, and major sourcing Google searches i.e., Boolean search, Metasearch, etc. He also focused on how TA people must invest time in learning about the industry and client first as well as their level of understanding about social media platforms and job portals before sourcing for any profile. Apart from this he also helped us in understanding how to keep the internal pipeline motivated while getting external talent on roles in the company by mixing both internal and external in an effective manner.





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Mr. Agrawal's comprehensive approach encompassed the entire spectrum of the candidate journey, beginning from the initial connection to culminating in exit interviews, thereby providing a holistic perspective on talent acquisition.
