INITIATE IT 3.0

The Centre for Entrepreneurship and Incubation (E Cell) of Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida, organized an "Initiate it 3.0" competition on Monday, August 21, 2023, in which competitors were supposed to find the weaknesses in the market leader ZOMATO and create a cutting-edge rival that not only addresses those weaknesses but also raises the bar for the sector. The event CEO was **Mr. Akshit Agarwal** and the technical work was done by his team of 11 members. There were a total of 13 teams and each one had to present his/her idea before the judges.

Competition Overview: Participants were required to identify the loopholes in the established company ZOMATO and create a competitor for the same, where this new company would cover the loopholes and be a competitor of ZOMATO.

Competition Sections:

Research Analysis: Participants were required to meticulously study Zomato's business model, services, and user experiences to identify areas for improvement. Innovation and Strategy: Armed with insights, participants devised a comprehensive business plan for their new venture. This plan would outline the innovative features, user-centric design, security measures, and competitive pricing that would set their startup apart.





Logo Design: In parallel, participants crafted a visually appealing logo that encapsulated the essence of their business idea. The logo reflected the startup's core values, uniqueness, and connection to the business concept.

Pitch Presentation: In a 5-minute pitch, participants presented their innovative business idea, highlighting the gaps they intend to fill and the ways they plan to exceed industry standards, and explaining the new logo they designed.

Evaluation: identification of loopholes in ZOMATO innovation and strategy for new business ideas

Relevance of the Logo: The logo should resonate with the business concept, symbolizing its core values and objectives.

Tagline: The tagline should succinctly convey the startup's value proposition, giving a glimpse into what it offers.

The winner of *Initiate* It 3.0 was Team Brainiacs, consisting of **Rajat Aggarwal**, **Devyani Srivastava**, and **Sayantani Maity**, with a prize of ₹ 5000/-, and the 1st runner-up was **Ameesha Mathur** with a prize of ₹ 3000/-, while the 2nd runner-up was Team Thinking Minds, consisting of **Apoorv Jha**, **Nishant Kumar**, and **Prateek Godhwani**. Jury members **Prof. Vardha Sardana** and **Prof. Jeeta Sarka**r awarded the prize to the winners.

Competitions like these are a way for businesses or entrepreneurs to encourage innovation and creativity by challenging participants to think critically about existing market leaders and develop solutions that can disrupt or improve upon the current market landscape. 






KNOWLEDGE SHARING SESSION
