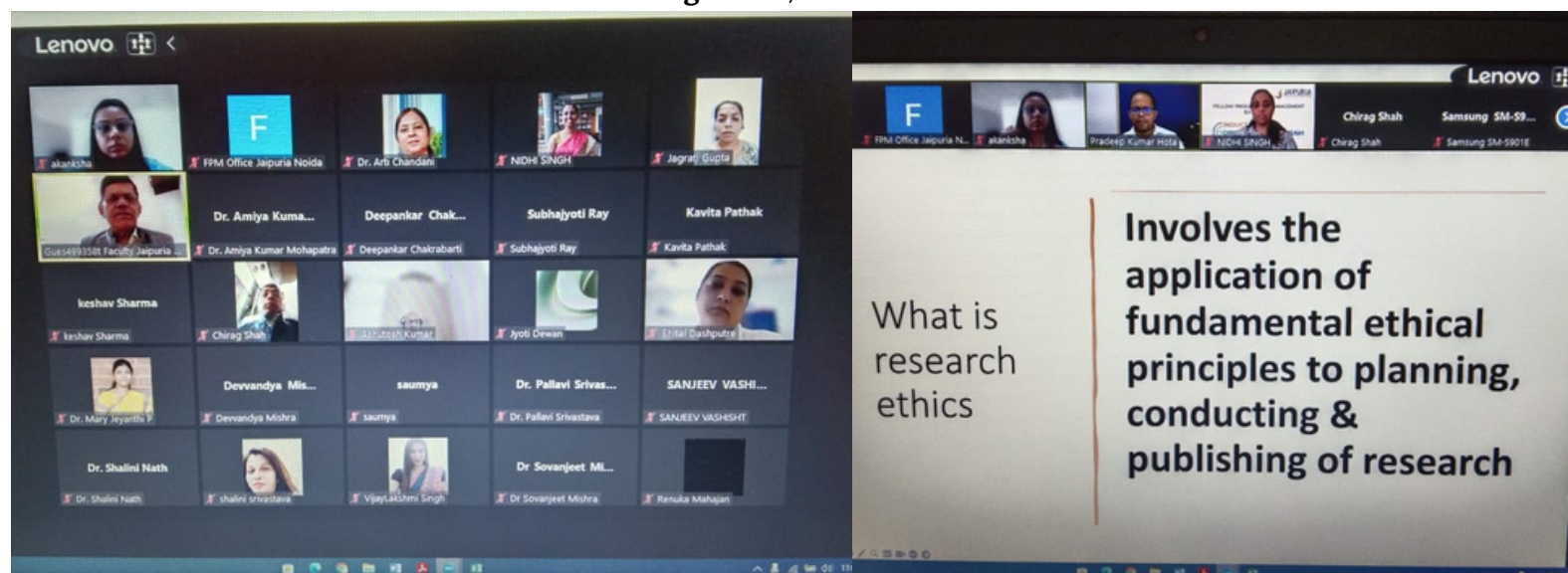

## FPM INDUCTION CEREMONY 2023

August 26, 2023



Jaipuria Institute of Management organized an induction ceremony for FPM batch 2023-27 on 26 Aug 2023. The ceremony was coordinated by Jaipuria, Noida under the Dean research's office.

The objective of this ceremony was to introduce the joining scholars to FPM at Jaipuria and its journey. The ceremony included an introduction, a Director's address, a session on career after FPM, a session on ethics in research, and a vote of thanks. **Dr. Pradeep Kumar Hota** was the guest of the session. In the introduction, all the scholars, directors, and guests were introduced. Then in the Director's address, **Dr. Kavita Pathak**, Director, Jaipuria, Lucknow shared the importance of research and her doctoral journey experience. She told about the huge opportunities in research and the vast knowledge base present for scholars pan Jaipuria. **Dr. Shubhajyoti Ray**, Director, of Jaipuria, Noida said that scholars should always aim high and have one focus area. He made scholars aware of various challenges in research and motivated them to publish in good journals. Then **Dr. Prabhat Pankaj**, Director, of Jaipuria, Jaipur sent a video message and talked about the importance of focusing on the topic. He said that one area should be chosen by the scholars, and they should become masters of that area. He emphasized the importance of time in the research journey. Then **Dr. Deepankar Chakrabarti**, Director, of Jaipuria, Indore talked about the importance of collaborations and what challenges come in the research journey. He said that scholars should focus on the quality of research.

The session on career after FPM was taken by **Dr. Devi Singh**, the distinguished faculty at Jaipuria, Noida. He talked about the linkage between research problems and industry requirements. He said that as a scholar, one should become an expert in some techniques and create his or her own USP. He guided huge opportunities in different areas like marketing, HR, and project management in industries. He also shared the structure of FPM programs in various top institutions.

The session on ethics in research was taken by the guest speaker, **Dr. Pradeep Kumar Hota**. He shared the various aspects of ethics in research and the issues which are prevalent these days. He said that while conducting research in management, one should have the absolute permission of respondents. He shared the ethical issues in publishing and that work must be withdrawn from one journal before sending to another.

The concluding remarks and vote of thanks were given by **Dr. Nidhi Singh**, Dean of research, Jaipuria, Noida. She concluded the session and thanked scholars for attending the ceremony, Directors, and speakers for sharing knowledge and guiding new scholars, and coordinators for coordinating the program.
