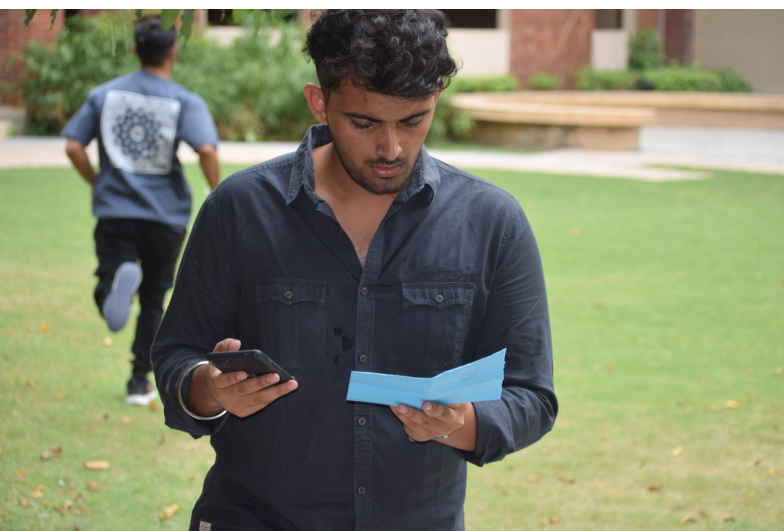

September 12, 2023

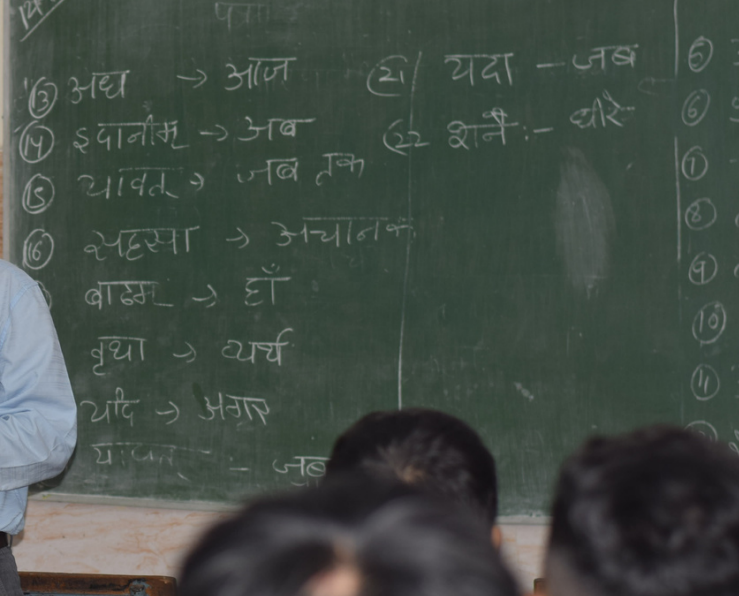
