

To enhance the placement preparedness of students for careers in the logistics industry, a workshop on "Logistics Management" was conducted on 7th Oct'23 (Saturday) on campus. The workshop was conducted by **Dr. Ashish Negi**, Senior Director-Service Logistics, DHL Supply Chain India Pvt. Ltd. The workshop was open to all interested PGDM students.

Starting the workshop, Dr. Ashish Negi briefed the students about the structure of the logistics industry, its present status, policy initiatives, and contemporary national and international trends. He also discussed some widely used domain concepts and industry practices employed in the logistics sector. Students were informed about the growth potential of the logistics industry and the career opportunities available for PGDM students. Dr. Negi shared and discussed frequently asked questions (personal as well as domain-related) for success in placement interviews for jobs in the logistics sector.
