Health & Hygiene Drive by Disha CSR Committee

The Disha CSR Committee of Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida conducted an initiative aimed at fostering health and hygiene awareness within underprivileged communities. On February 28th, 2024, at 01:30 pm, they organized a Health & Hygiene Drive in a slum near Aditya Mall, Indirapuram.

The donations witnessed remarkable support from both faculty members and total generously contributed essential items. Α students who of approximately 900 items, including soaps, shampoos, toothpaste, toothbrushes, Vim bars, Surf Excel bars, hair oil, Betadine ointment, antiseptic liquids (Dettol and Savlon), and sanitary pads, were donated. With this drive, they were able to serve 150+ underprivileged people who required these necessities.

The primary objective was to educate females in the community about proper sanitary pad usage and disposal. Additionally, they conducted sessions on the correct application of antiseptic liquids such as Dettol and Savlon for bathing and first aid purposes, addressing minor cuts and wounds.

The drive's success was evident through the active involvement of junior coordinators and the positive reception from the beneficiaries. Beyond the distribution of donated items, their efforts aimed to instill sustainable hygiene practices, fostering a healthier and more informed community.
