HRIS Workshop for Hands-on Learning

"To take classroom learning to the next level, a 6-session hands-on workshop in the HRIS course for the students of the sixth trimester was organized on March 18–19 and 21, 2024. The resource person for the workshop was **Mr. Vinay Dalal**, cofounder and CEO of TalBrum (an HPSPL initiative), Gurugram (India). HRIS course faculty, **Dr. Abdul Qadir**, welcomed Mr. Vinay Dalal and presented him with a green tree certificate wherein a bountiful tree at Trees for Leopards, Nainital, Uttarakhand (India) was planted in his name.

The workshop opened with an introduction to its basic premise and broad coverage. The six sessions of this workshop included modules like talent acquisition, ATS, leave and attendance management, payroll, learning and development, and performance management systems. The pedagogy adopted by the resource person for all these modules was configuration and hands-on demonstration of working on HR functions and processes through the cloud-based software **TalBrum**. Students were given individual access credentials for the software, TalBrum, to practice and learn hands-on. To keep the sessions engaging and purposeful, Mr. Vinay kept the participants occupied with engaging questions and the logic behind HR functions and processes. To ensure the learning from the workshop, a comprehensive project was followed by an individual assessment that finally culminated in the form of certifications.

Students felt extremely enriched by this workshop. They were rightly equipped with HR hands-on knowledge before embarking on their corporate journey. They acknowledged that this workshop has added extremely important value to their learning curve. In the end, Mr. Vinay also appreciated the students and their curiosity about learning about HRIS.
