The event was organized by the Hindu Business Line and was powered by NABARD in association with FICCI. The initiative was taken by the Economics area faculty members, **Prof. Amarnath Tripathi, Prof. Ritika Gugnani,** and the Area Chair, **Prof. Vranda Jain.** The event provided a deep dive into the nuances of the national budget and its implications for various sectors.

The session was graced by the presence of distinguished speakers, with the Guest of Honor being **V. Anantha Nageswaran**, the Chief Economic Advisor to the Government of India. His address provided an insightful overview of the economic strategies underpinning the budget, emphasizing sustainable growth and fiscal prudence. The Chief Guest, **Sanjay Malhotra**, the Hon'ble Revenue Secretary of the Government of India, followed with a detailed discourse on the revenue measures and fiscal policies introduced in the budget. His address highlighted the government's commitment to enhancing tax compliance and boosting revenue through progressive reforms. A stimulating panel discussion on postbudget analysis featured eminent personalities from diverse sectors. **Ashok Gulati**, Distinguished Professor at ICRIER and Chief Editor of AF-TAB; **D. K. Pant**, Chief Economist at India Rating Research; **A. Balasubramanian**, Managing Director and CEO of Aditya Birla Sun Life AMC Limited; Jyoti Vij, Director General of FICCI; and **Sitikantha Pattanaik**, Chief Economist at NABARD.

The session was a remarkable opportunity for our students to engage with leading economists and policymakers, enriching their understanding of the budgetary process and its broader economic context.
