On 12th September, Disha, the CSR Committee organized a drive with Save The Girl NGO to raise awareness among 150+ children (ages 2 to 13) about "Good Touch and Bad Touch" at Pratibha International School. The event focused on teaching personal safety in a simple, interactive manner. The drive began with a skit that portrayed two students experiencing different types of touch – good touch from family and friends, and bad touch from strangers and classmates. The skit's key message was to encourage the children to say "Nahi" whenever they felt uncomfortable or experienced bad touch, empowering them to protect themselves.

Following the skit, **Prof. Rohan Bhalla, Prof. Varda Sardana, Prof. Poornima Madan and Prof. Vranda Jain** conducted an educational session on personal safety zones. Using life-size posters of a boy and a girl, they explained boundaries and how to differentiate between safe and unsafe touch from family, friends, society, and strangers.

The session was highly interactive, with the children participating in discussions, singing songs, and dancing, making the learning experience fun and engaging. The event concluded with refreshments, allowing the children to relax and interact further.

Overall, the drive was successful in educating the children on personal safety in a positive and engaging way, ensuring they left feeling more confident in recognizing and responding to unsafe situations.

Guest Session on Strategic Management Titled: "Brand Marketing"

On 12 September 2024, Jaipuria Institute of Management hosted a session titled "Brand Marketing," organized by CMC, Noida, delivered by **Mr. Puravansh Maitreya**, Marketing Head at LAVA. With prior experience at renowned brands like ZEEL and Deloitte Consulting, Mr. Maitreya is known for leading award-winning campaigns and executing successful go-to-market strategies, driving impressive ROI for global brands.

Mr. Maitreya began by exploring the concept of brand value, explaining that it represents the additional worth a brand brings to its products or services. He emphasized that brand value is shaped by the image a brand projects and the emotional or psychological associations it fosters in the minds of consumers. He cited Apple's sleek design and minimalist aesthetic as examples of how visual elements create strong brand associations.

Mr. Maitreya also highlighted the importance of a consistent brand message, which communicates a brand's core values, promises, and benefits through advertising, customer service, and public relations. He used examples like Thar, synonymous with adventure, and Coca-Cola and Pepsi, which target youthful audiences by positioning themselves as fun and cool. He stressed the need for companies to align their visual identity with their messaging to build trust and emotional connections. For instance, Domino's 30-minute delivery guarantee builds customer loyalty by adding value beyond the product. The session concluded with a Q&A segment, where attendees engaged with the speaker's insights.

These early career years are a time to embrace discomfort, learning, and change. Shifting your mindset opens up opportunities for growth and development.


