ANNUAL BOOK FAIR 2024 AT JAIPURIA INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT, NOIDA

The Learning Resources Centre (LRC) of Jaipuria Institute of Management, Noida, organized its 11th Annual Book Fair on December 4, 2024, at the campus front lawns. The event was inaugurated by Dean Academics, Dr. Ritika Gugnani, and Dean Administration, Dr. V. K. Tomar, in the presence of faculty, staff, student volunteers, and exhibitors. The Director, who was out of the station, sent his best wishes for the event's success. The Deans, accompanied by library committee members and faculty, visited all stalls, engaging with publishers and vendors to recommend a wide range of books.

This year's fair saw participation from the largest number of reputed publishers and vendors, including some from distant states. A special highlight of the event was a voluntary donation drive involving exhibitors, faculty, staff, and visitors. The collected funds were directed towards providing food and ration for an NGO that supports an orphanage, offering shelter and education to orphans.
