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Hiranya the Finance club presents Seminar on Security Investment by Prof. A.R. Tripathi

The Finance Club of Jaipuria Institute of Management Noida recently hosted an enriching session delivered by Prof. A.R. Tripathi, a distinguished academic and expert in finance and commerce. He has held various esteemed positions, such as Professor of Commerce, Dean of Students Welfare, and Head & Dean of the Faculty of Commerce at Banaras Hindu University (BHU). His academic journey includes active roles in significant committees such as the Investment Committees of BHU, IIT BHU, and IGNOU, New Delhi. With decades of experience in teaching, research, and financial education, Prof. Tripathi has been an instrumental figure in promoting investor awareness and financial literacy. During the session, Prof. Tripathi shared invaluable insights on the art of investing. He emphasized the importance of making informed decisions, avoiding impulsive trading, and understanding market trends. Highlighting the risks of speculative trading, he advised students to prioritize long-term goals and focus on investments backed by solid fundamentals.

The discussion on mutual funds provided clarity on how they work as an investment vehicle. Prof. Tripathi explained the types of mutual funds, their benefits in portfolio diversification, and the significance of choosing funds aligned with one's risk tolerance and financial objectives. He also underscored the role of Asset Management Companies (AMCs) and the importance of thorough research before investing.

A critical segment of the session was dedicated to the role and functions of SEBI (Securities and Exchange Board of India). Prof. Tripathi detailed how SEBI ensures market integrity, protects investor interests, and enforces regulations to foster transparency in the financial ecosystem. He also touched upon the importance of adhering to financial laws and staying vigilant against fraudulent schemes. The session was a rich blend of theoretical knowledge and practical wisdom, leaving students with a deeper understanding of the financial world. The Finance Committee is proud to have provided this opportunity, reinforcing its commitment to fostering financial literacy and professional growth among students.

The "Tark-Where words Ignite the Change" debate event, organized by the Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat Committee, aimed to engage students in discussing and debate on current affairs while honing their logical thinking and public speaking skills. In this unique challenge, participants formed teams of 2 members to present their logical and deep knowledge from across the World, showcasing diverse perspectives on an overall domain.

Each team was encouraged to present creatively, with the flexibility to talk about their deep knowledge on a given topic. Their performance time was capped at 6 minutes, to evaluate the team and qualify for the second round, In the next round 4 teams competing each other for the final round, In the third and final rounds the time was capped at 8 minutes for both the finalist teams. The total no. of participants was 8 teams and each team contained 2 members so the total no. of participants was 16.

The distinguished judges for the event were Dr. Jeeta Sarkar, who assessed each team's ability to deliver impactful knowledge and respond confidently during the event.

Despite fierce competition among 8 teams, Team The Brainiacs ultimately stood out, demonstrating exceptional insight and confidence in their. Their teamwork and creativity won the judges' Favor, securing them the winning position. The runners-up, Team We-Bishaan, also impressed the judges with their strong content delivery and ability to tackle challenging questions with poise.

Corporate Session on Service Recovery

The session was an inspiring mix of strategy and engagement, leaving us equipped with actionable ideas and an improved understanding of CRM best practices.


With hard work and a focused approach, I converted a daunting challenge into an extraordinary achievement, proving the power of perseverance and self-belief.

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
