- Q.1.** What are the powers and composition of Competition Commission of India under Competition Act 2002?

- Q.3.** What is One Person Company as per Companies Act, 2013? What are the differences between One Person Company and Sole Proprietorship?
- Q.4.** Who is "Unpaid Seller" as per the Sale of Goods Act. Illustrate with examples.
- Q.5.** Who is "Consumer" and what are their rights under Consumer Protection Act?
- Q.6.** A is manufacturer of jewelry delivers certain articles of jewelry to B (whose business is to travel about the country selling jewellery) upon the term that they should remain the property of A until sold or paid for. B fraudulently pledges the jewellery with a pawn-broker and money lender. Is the pledge valid?
- Q.7.** A entered into an agreement with S to deliver five dozen bottles of a particular brand of champagne to be manufactured in his factory. The champagne could not be manufactured because of strike by the workers and A failed to supply the said dozen of champagne to S. Decide whether A can be exempted from liability under the provisions of the Indian Contract Act, 1872
- Q.8.** Ram, Rahim and Robert are partners of software business and jointly promises to pay Rs.30,000/- to Raheja. Over a period of time Rahim became insolvent, but his assets are sufficient to pay one-fourth of his debts. Robert is compelled to pay the whole. Decide whether Robert is required to pay whole amount himself to Raheja in discharging joint promise.

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
